<p>The Kraków Special Economic Zone was created towards the end of 1997. Krakowski Park Technologiczny Sp. z o.o. is the Company which is successfully managing the Zone. The Company was established by the three largest academies in Kraków: Kraków Technical University, Akademia Górniczo-Hutnicza (Mining and Metallurgy Academy) and the Jagiellonian University. The founders also include city and province authorities. The main reason for establishing the Kraków Technology Park, with the status of a special economic zone, was an attempt to find instruments to support the restructuring of industry in the Małopolska region. To date, the Kraków Technology Park has issued 44 permits to conduct business activities in the Zone. We have attracted the MAN concern to Niepołomice – so far the largest greenfield investment in the Małopolskie Province. The companies which have started operating in the Zone have created 4 000 new jobs so far, and have declared they will be creating 3 500 more by 2009.</p> <p>The achievements of the Kraków Technology Park in regional economic development have been publicly recognised. In February 2006, its Management Board was awarded the prestigious title of "Małopolska Leader – best undertaking of 2005 in Małopolska".</p> <p>The activities of the Kraków Technology Park are shaping the new image and character of both the city and the region. Formerly dominated by heavy industry, Kraków is now considered a city where high-tech industry is developing dynamically, and the Kraków Technology Park, together with companies which have invested in the Zone, are the best examples of this new image. In the past, the city's economic image was based on the presence of the Huta im. Lenina steel mill, now it is ComArch, Motorola, ACS, Shell, Ericpol, and other companies from the IT and modern financial services sector.</p>
